
MLCUG - THE ANDROID CONNECTION

- What & Why to introduce & familiarize you with some ways to establish interface connections with your Android device for the purpose of managing apps & transferring data & media, all without rooting the device or using apps not offered in the Google or Amazon app stores






- As USB Mass Storage device
 - o About drivers
 - mass storage should work w/o special drivers
 - Windows may complain about missing drivers
 - modem driver for tethering
 - may be other drivers for other features
 - o Enabling thru Notifications menu to access SDcard







- o The DCIM folder
 - DCIM = Digital Camera IMages
 - folder is in Mass Storage



- General file management apps I've installed (all WiFi)
 - o Remote Desktop
 - includes limited CLI
 - AirDroid
 - similar to Remote Desktop, but no CLI
 - o File Expert (the Swiss Army knife for Android file management)
 - All basic file operations Copy, Paste, Move, Create and Rename your files and folders
 - FTP/HTTP Server Share & Manage your files without a USB cable. Web management featuring a Windows style interface!
 - Cloud Storage Use one app to access various cloud services!
 Support Dropbox, Box.net, SkyDrive and more!
 - SMB, FTP, SFTP, FTPS, WebDAV and Bluetooth OBEX Client -Access your host computer from your phone
 - Bluetooth Full-featured Bluetooth capabilities include OBEX FTP, OPP
 - NFC Support. You can use NFC-enabled phone to transfer files and apps.
 - WiFi Send. Directly send files via WiFi between File Expert powered phones
 - App Manager Uninstall/Backup apps. Support silent operations if on rooted devices
 - Archive manager Create and decompress ZIP archive, Decompress RAR. You can view your ZIP/RAR/GZIP/TAR/TGZ/BZ file just like accessing a folder and directly decompress unique files and folders
 - Thumbnails view thumbnails
 - Text Viewer
 - Image Viewer supports both local and remote folder
 - Search SD card, perform operations on search results
- Media file management I've used
 - o iSyncr & iSyncr WiFi addon
 - music management & syncing for iTunes users
 - USB version installs PC app in Mass Storage
 - WiFi addon requires server on PC
 - Miro on PC
 - https://www.getmiro.com/
 - more than just an interface to your portable device -Android or iOS
 - cross platform Linux, Mac, Windows
 - requires USB connection to portable device
 - music & video processing, management, & syncing
 - o Calibre on PC
 - http://calibre-ebook.com/
 - easily sync your digital library via WiFi
 - Aldiko app is recommended reader for ease of compatibility

- for Browser ease of use, especially on Android phone
 - o GBookmark
 - tried other Google Bookmark utilities, but they gave me problems
- for ease of setup & use
 - o use Google services, but not a requirement
 - o email I use Google Mail
 - o contacts (phone directory) I use Google Contacts
 - o event reminders I use Google Calendar
- Presentation Tools
 - o especially for devices lacking video connectivity
 - o for screen snapshots & screencasting
 - o Requirements for capture / display of screen on PC
 - USB connection between Android device & PC
 - Java SDK (Java Software Development Kit)

 - **NOTE:** by default the Apple supplied Java on Macs is the SDK. So Mac users do not need to concern themselves with this if running Apple supplied Java.
 - Android SDK (Android Software Development Kit)

 - the instructions cover how to screen snapshot & rotate
 - manual capture of screen; no auto refresh

 - I have not been able to get this software working
 - But, found some of the installation info helpful when installing the other 2 options listed here, especially info about the Android SDK & USB driver info & Android debug setting

 - o Slow refresh rate (about 4-5 fps)
 - o Not all key codes are mapped. See KeyMapping
 - o Does not support automatic screen rotation
 - Full mouse and keyboard control FOR ROOTED DEVICES ONLY
 - o Landscape mode (right click)
 - o Video recording
 - o Basic file browser
